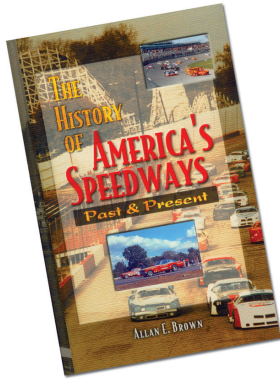


THE HISTORY OF AMERICA'S SPEEDWAYS
